- Youth to Adult ratio ~1
- Good, Fun activities
- Many items at Silver (NOT Gold)

2015 Gold Lodges

- Item Averages @ Silver:
 - #2 \$ Contribution/Member = \$17.20
 - #3 Growth = 2.45%
 - #4 Retention = 79%
 - #5 Election Rate = 78%
 - #6 Induction Rate = 78.5%
 - #8 BH Conversion = 36%
 - #9 Service Hrs/Member = 10.5
 - #11 Visits = 68.5%



2015 Gold Lodges

- Item Averages @ Gold:
 - #15 Camp Promo = 87%
 - #16 LEC Participation = 96.5% (most $\geq 100\%$)
