- Key skills the adviser brings

 - Experience
 - Planning
- Teach the Chairman "what" and help the Chairman with the "how"

Role of Youth Chairman

- Youth Chairman
 - Organizer
 - Recruiter
 - Delegator
 - Project Manager & Integrator
 - Motivator

Common Committees

- Common committees include:
 - ProgramBanquet
 - Location/facilitiesFood
 - Logo/patch designFellowship
 - Memorabilia (patches, t-shirts)
 Promotion
- Multiple committee benefits:
 - The Chairman does not have to do everything
 - Gets more Arrowmen involved
 - Develops future lodge leaders
