

## Pre and Post Adventures at Philmont Scout Ranch

Philmont Scout Ranch is pleased to offer lodge contingents traveling to and from NOAC 2024 a pre/post trip adventure!

To participate, all youth attendees must be accompanied by a parent/guardian or an adult leader. The contingent must follow the Guide to Safe Scouting's adult supervision requirement, be a registered member of the BSA, complete the BSA Annual Health and Medical Record parts A, B & C and meet all the height/weight requirements for backcountry access. Program payments are: 50% due at time of registration and the remaining full amount is due 30 days prior to arrival at Philmont Scout Ranch. All participants will need to provide their own bedding.

### 3 Day Conservation Adventure - \$150/person July 26-29, 2024

*(Capacity 40 participants, must be 14+ years of age or 13 and completed 8<sup>th</sup> grade to attend)*

Perfect for past OA High Adventure participants, Philmont Scout Ranch alumni, and lodge contingents, this program will spend one night in the backcountry working and hiking in the Deer Lake Mesa area of Philmont Scout Ranch. Attendees will have the opportunity to help re-open trails burned in the 2018 Ute Park Fire and will be able to participate in a re-dedication ceremony of the Vaca trail.

- **July 26, 2024:** Arrive at Philmont Scout Ranch between 1-3PM, enjoy an evening welcome dinner, and stay in base camp overnight.
- **July 27, 2024:** Trail work in the Window Rock area with an overnight at Clarks Fork
- **July 28, 2024:** Hike to Turkey Creek Trailhead (9 miles) for the Vaca Trail Rededication followed by dinner in basecamp and the opening campfire
- **July 29, 2024:** Departure day for NOAC with breakfast served by Philmont Scout Ranch

### 2 Day Backcountry Overnight - \$100/person July, 27-29, 2024

*(Capacity 40 participants, must be 11+ years of age to attend)*

If the lodge contingent strives for more adventure, this is for you! Get right off the bus and hike to a backcountry camp for a classic Philmont Scout Ranch campfire show and a night under the stars. The next day take a hike and participate in a conservation program before heading back to basecamp and then onto Boulder, CO.

- **July 27, 2024:** Arrive at Philmont Scout Ranch from 1-2:30PM, load the bus by 3:30PM and complete a short Hike to Clarks Fork (2.5 miles) for chuckwagon dinner and campfire show
- **July 28, 2024:** Hike to Window Rock (6 miles round trip) and participate in a conservation project followed by dinner in basecamp and opening campfire
- **July 29, 2024:** Departure day for NOAC with breakfast served by Philmont Scout Ranch

### Basecamp Overnight - \$75/person July 28-29, 2024

Need someplace to stop and break-up your drive? Philmont Scout Ranch is perfect. Spend the evening with campers and other contingents acclimating and preparing for an exciting conference week!

- **July 28, 2024:** Arrive between 1-2:30PM to take a short hike to Lover's Leap with spectacular views of the Tooth of Time followed by dinner in basecamp and the opening campfire
- **July 29, 2024:** Departure day for NOAC with breakfast served

### Post-NOAC Overnight - \$75/person\* August 3-4, 2024.

Relax after your conference week with an overnight at Philmont Scout Ranch. Enjoy an evening tour of the historic Villa Philmonte and a night at the National Scouting Museum.

- **August 3, 2024:**
    - Arrive at Philmont Scout Ranch by 3:00PM
    - 5:00PM Buffalo BBQ served at the Philmont Conservation Office
    - 6:00-8:00PM National Scouting Museum open house and tours of the Villa Philmonte
  - **August 4, 2024:** Departure day for home with breakfast served by Philmont Scout Ranch
