If food will be cooked and/or served at your display, please answer the following questions:

What food will be served?

What preparations will be needed (i.e., cooking on propane stove/dutch ovens, etc)?

What shipping arrangements will be used for food?

What storage facilities will be utilized?

What plans do you have to properly clean and disinfect all "kitchen" equipment (i.e., tables, knives, pots and pans, mixers, cutting boards, etc.)?

LATEX OR PLASTIC GLOVES MUST BE SUPPLIED BY THE LODGE FOR ALL FOOD PREPARERS/HANDLERS/SERVERS.

At the conclusion of founder's day all food not eaten must be thrown away rather than stored for later use.
